THE HURN NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

An Inspector has now been appointed to examine our draft Hurn Neighbourhood Plan. The Parish Council has submitted the draft Plan to BCP Council and we are now in their hands to take it forward with the Inspector. Unfortunately, due to their high workload in producing the draft BCP Local Plan, they have put our Plan on hold. We have been promised that they will proceed to examination after the launch of the BCP Local Plan on 20th March. We will update further on this at the Annual Assembly on 8th April.


The consultation will run for 6 weeks until Friday 3rd May 2024. The draft Plan sets out strategic policies for housing, employment, and the environment until 2039. It also includes 33 individual Ward policies relating to every Ward area in Bournemouth Christchurch and Poole. Local BCP Councillors have had input into those policies.
