Defibrillator Installed - Hurn Bridge Sports Club

Councilors are delighted that a defibrillator has been installed in Hurn Bridge Sports Club. The Club successfully applied for a grant from your Ward Councillor to buy and install a public access defibrillator.

The defibrillator is mounted in a secure cabinet on the outside of Hurn Bridge Sports Club. The defibrillator is available for emergency use by members of the public. If a medical emergency occurs and you need to use the defibrillator ring the emergency services on 999 and they will give you the code to access the cabinet. The defibrillator gives you instructions how to use it, as will the emergency services. Councilors would like to thank the management of Hurn Bridge Sports Club for this initiative.
