HURN PARISH NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN REFERENDUM RESULT

On Thursday 24th October 2024 Hurn Parish residents voted in a referendum to accept the Hurn Neighbourhood Plan. A simple majority was required and this was achieved with a result of 89.63% in favour with a turnout of 23.24%. Thank you to all those who voted.

Once approved by full BCP Council in December, The Plan will become part of the statutory development plan for the area. This statutory status will give the Neighbourhood Plan weight in the BCP planning process and its policies must be taken into account when planning decisions are made in Hurn Parish.

Parish Chairman and BCP Ward Cllr. Margaret Phipps said “I am absolutely delighted at the referendum result. It has taken over 4 years and a lot of effort from Hurn residents and Parish Cllrs. to put this Plan together. We applied for grants to fund the whole process and engaged a local planning consultant to help us. The policies in the Plan will give us influence in the planning process to help preserve the historic and rural nature of the Parish”

BCP is asking residents to have they say on the work they are doing to prepare proposals to balance the Council’s budget for 2025/26 and beyond, in line with their financial situation.
